

Scrapyard Golf T&C

General participation

- All players participate in Scrapyard Golf at their own risk. By taking part, customers agree to follow all safety instructions, centre rules, and staff guidance at all times. Discobowl staff are present to ensure equipment is used correctly and safely.
- Children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times. Discobowl does not provide supervision. Supervising adults must remain on site while children are participating.
- Anyone with a medical condition, injury, or mobility concern should consider whether participation is suitable, as this activity involves physical movement and uneven surfaces.

Behaviour and safety

- Running is not permitted.
- Climbing on scenery or course structures is not permitted.
- Physical contact between players is not permitted.
- Crouching or lying on the course is not permitted.
- Foul, abusive, or threatening language is not permitted.
- Flat or low heeled footwear must be worn.
- Disruptive, antisocial, unsafe, or violent behaviour towards staff or other customers will result in removal from the premises without refund. This decision will be made by the Duty Manager. Serious incidents may be reported to the police.

Bookings and arrival

- Players must arrive at least 10 minutes before their booked session time. Late arrival may result in reduced play time or refusal of entry without refund.
- For group or party bookings, changes to group size must be notified at least 24 hours in advance. Fewer attendees on the day may still be charged at the original booking value.
- Sessions may occasionally be delayed due to operational reasons.

Liability and property

- Discobowl accepts no responsibility for lost, stolen, or damaged personal belongings.
- Discobowl shall not be liable for injury, loss, or damage resulting from misuse of equipment, failure to follow instructions, failure to comply with these terms, or lack of appropriate supervision of children.
