

Ninja Tag T&C

General participation

- All participants take part in Ninja Tag at their own risk.
- By participating, customers agree to follow all staff instructions, safety briefings, and activity rules.
- Staff are present to ensure equipment is used correctly and safely.
- Children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times. The company does not provide supervision.

Health and safety

- Ninja Tag is a physically active activity involving movement, obstacles, and padded equipment.
- Participants should consider whether the activity is suitable for them.
- Anyone with injuries, medical conditions, or mobility concerns should speak to staff before participating.

Behaviour and activity rules

- Running in unsafe areas, climbing on non activity structures, or rough behaviour is not permitted.
- Physical contact between participants is not permitted unless part of the structured game instructions.
- Equipment must be used only as instructed by staff.
- Unsafe behaviour may result in removal from the activity without refund.

Equipment use

- Activity equipment must not be removed from the activity area.
- Participants must follow instructions on how to use obstacles and tagging equipment safely.

Bookings and sessions

- Participants must arrive in time for the safety briefing.
- Late arrivals may miss their session and may not be entitled to a refund.
- Sessions may occasionally be delayed for operational reasons.

Liability and property

- The company accepts no responsibility for lost, stolen, or damaged belongings.
- The company shall not be liable for injury resulting from misuse of equipment, failure to follow instructions, or lack of supervision.

Operational rights

- The company reserves the right to refuse admission.
- The company reserves the right to amend activity times or withdraw the activity for safety

or operational reasons.
